These exchange programs are unique opportunities for Oregon high school students to gain leadership skills, network with teen leaders from around the world, and learn about other cultures. Apply today!

COVERED EXPENSES:

Domestic and international air travel, visa fees, program activities, lodging, meals, some cultural events, and accident and sickness insurance are all paid for by the US Department of State.

STUDENT ELIGIBILITY:

Must be 15–17 years old, a US citizen, and have at least one year of high school remaining at the start of the exchange. For the Youth Ambassadors programs, students must attend public high school and not traveled outside of North America.

ADULT ELIGIBILITY:

Must work with youth in a school or community setting and have had no previous travel to countries of the exchange.

LEARN MORE:

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US – Iraqi Young Leaders Exchange Program

July/August 2017

Forty high school students from the US and Iraq will participate together on a four week leadership exchange based in the US. Participants will begin the program in Brattleboro, Vermont at World Learning's SIT Graduate Institute. The group will then be split into three host communities, with Oregon students traveling to Chicago or Tulsa, Oklahoma. The program will end with a week of civic education in Washington, DC.
